Class Overview

In this class, students will learn everything they need to know about reading the notes on the treble clef staff. We will learn what a treble clef is, what notes are, we'll learn how the musical alphabet works, tips for reading the notes on the spaces versus the lines and we'll learn about ledger line notes! We will also spend time practicing reading the musical notes to apply what we have learned! I hope this class will launch your students' excitement for music and make them WANT to practice!!

Class Objectives

1. What is a treble clef?
2. What is a note?
3. Introduce the musical alphabet and the staff.
4. Learn to read “space” notes.
5. Learn to read “line” notes.
6. Learn about ledger line notes.
7. Go over a practice worksheet.
